HINTS FOR A GREAT PHOTO:



Try to avoid clothing with bold logos or designs on them as they are distracting and take the focus of the photo away from where it should be...your child.



If you prefer a patterned shirt for your child's photos, go for a simple or subtle pattern rather than a very bold one.



Solid colours work really well for photos. Try to find something in a solid, soft colour. Bright colours can detract from your child's face making them seem washed out.



Choose clothing that fits properly. Do not pick outfits that are too big, or try to squeeze into outgrown cloths. Make sure your child can comfortably sit, stand and lay down in their outfit.



Long hair is best styled so that it is out of your child's face, and especially out of their eyes.



If this will be a new experience for your child, spend some time talking with them about what will happen. A child that comes in with an idea of what to expect is more likely to be happy and cooperative on picture day.



Above all else, please make sure your child is comfortable.



Practice a nice smile at home ... not too big and not too small.
